School Facilities (2008-09)

Summary of the Most Recent Site Inspection:

The district takes great efforts to ensure that all schools are clean, safe, and functional. To assist in this effort, the district uses a facility survey instrument developed by the State of California Office of Public School Construction. The results of this survey are available at the school office or at the district office.

On July 8, 2008 a site visit was conducted at Idyllwild School. Based on the field observations the following was found:

Repairs Needed:

- One boy's restroom stall door missing (ADA) and one stall would not latch; one girl's restroom ADA stall door would not latch.
- Stained and damaged ceiling tiles in two classrooms; carpet stained in one classroom; one classroom carpet needs to be replaced.
- One classroom fire extinguisher needs to be charges.
- Several rooms have fixtures, lights, and/or lamps out.
- MPR roof leaks over kitchen door; possible roof leaks in one classroom.
- One classroom generally messy.

Corrective Actions Planned or Taken:

The district has taken the appropriate action to correct all deficiencies.
