In an effort to launch this program, we have begun making trips once per month out to pilot schools, and are in the process of gradually rolling the program out to other select schools.

Although the full program is not yet available, we would like the opportunity to start on a limited basis with as many schools as possible, so that when the full program is ready, we can roll it out right away.

To present the program, following are a list of activities that an Altura Credit Union representative will do:

- Visit the school on selected "Deposit Days" to accept deposits for the kids and credit their accounts.
- Discuss financial goals, and help the children set their own goals.
- Teach the kids how to track their balances, and help them save by recommending the appropriate products to reach their saving goals.

To open the account for your child, we will need:

- **Your** photo ID and Social Security Card or other secondary form of ID.
- **Your child's** Social Security number and school id, if they have one, or Birth Certificate if they don't.
- \$12 membership fee, and opening deposit of any amount.
