HIGHLIGHTS OF GOVERNING BOARD ACTIONS

The Governing Board at their January 21, 2003 meeting took the following actions:

- ✓ Accepted gifts and donations totaling \$43,080.
- ✓ Approved at second and final reading, selected Series 0000, 3000 and 5000 Policies.
- ✓ Approved agreement with Stuart and Associates to provide legislative advocacy services for the purpose of receiving funding for state school facilities funding and other District State legislative issues for a term of one year.
- ✓ Approved agreement for Independent Contract Services with Carlos Saucedo to provide psychological assessments, per agreement number 03-155.
- ✓ Approved revised courses of study at second and final reading.
- ✓ Approved Groundhog Job Shadow Day Field Trips on February 6, 2003.
- ✓ Approved to submit an Application for the Enhancing Education Through Technology Grant for the No Child Left Behind Act.
- ✓ Approved Notice of Completion for installation of three relocatable classrooms at Santa Fe Middle School.
- ✓ Approved contract with Richard Navarro for DSA inspection services on New Middle School #1.
- ✓ Approved contract termination for Scott Bedgood, as the DSA inspector for Harmony Elementary School.
- ✓ Approved contract with Dana F. Estes for DSA inspection services on Harmony Elementary School.
- ✓ Approved Inland Foundation Engineering to provide construction testing services on New Middle School #1.
- ✓ Approved to form a Citizen's Advisory Committee and nominate committee members to recommend a name for the new middle school.
- ✓ Approved at first reading revised BP/AR 6153 School-Sponsored Trips.
- ✓ Approved at first reading with second and final reading at future meetings, selected Series 5000 Policies.

DRAFT MISSION AND VISION STATEMENTS

The Governing Board received the “draft” Mission and Vision Statements for review. The Board will discuss and possibly adopt both the Statements at the February 4, 2003 meeting.

STUDY SESSION

Sandy Packham, Facilities Planner, and representatives of douglas e barnhart, inc., the District’s construction management firm, presented an overview of ongoing and future building and modernization projects.

Summer 2003 projects include the modernization of both the first and second floors of the main building at Hemet High School, *modernization/renovations* at Santa Fe, Little Lake, Acacia, Ramona, and Whittier schools, and various other projects throughout the District.

In addition to the modernization projects, construction has begun on McSweeny and Harmony Elementary Schools, which are scheduled to open for the 2003-04 school year and on New Middle School #1 scheduled to open for the 2004-05 school year. Both Measure E \$\$\$’s and State building \$\$\$’s are being used to fund these projects.
